COMMONWEALTH'S ENTRY OF NOLLE PROSEQUI

The Commonwealth hereby enters a Nolle Prosequi prior to arraignment in this case pursuant to Rule 16 of the Massachusetts Rules of Criminal Procedure. As reasons, the Commonwealth states the following:

1. The Norfolk District Attorney's Office (NDAO) has screened and authorized the pre-trial diversion of Mr. Paul K. Halloran, given his age and lack of criminal record.
2. Individuals accepted for pre-trial diversion must acknowledge their conduct, seek care to address inappropriate behaviors and show a willingness to engage in the community.
3. Mr. Halloran has provided proof that he has sought and is still engaged in individual counseling to address the behavior that resulted in his court involvement.
4. Further, Mr. Halloran has provided proof that he has completed forty (40) hours of community service at the Boys and Girls Club of East Boston.
5. Additionally, Mr. Halloran has provided confirmation that he is enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student at Suffolk University. Progress reports provided show that he is excelling in his studies and has been elected to the Student Senate.


For these reasons, the Commonwealth enters a Nolle Prosequi on this matter.
