DETECTIVE SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

- (1) On 08/11/2025, I (Detective PAUL M MCGOVERN) was assigned by Sgt. Casey to conduct a follow up investigation related to a past missing person's report.
- (2) On 08/08/2025, at approximately 0748hrs, Patrolman Jeffrey Perry was dispatched to 107 County Street for a well-being check.
- (3) On 08/08/2025, at approximately 0759hrs, Ptlm. Perry arrived on scene. Ptlm. Nicholas Miranda arrived shortly after. Ptlm. Perry spoke with the reporting party who was identified as Gregory Groom (G. GROOM) stated that his ex-girlfriend who is identified as Kylee M. Monteiro (K. MONTEIRO) was 2 1/2 months pregnant had walked away from his residence on 8/7/25 at approximately 1900hrs. According to G. GROOM, he informed her that she could no longer stay with him. Ptlm. Perry said that G. GROOM stated that he and K. MONTEIRO had an argument about her staying with him, so she left the residence and was last seen walking eastbound on County Street, towards Reservoir Ave.
- (4) K. MONTEIRO was last seen wearing a Red T-Shirt with "Get Over It" printed on the front. Ripped blue jeans and tan boots. K. MONTEIRO was described as a heavy-set female, 6'0 tall, brown eyes, brown hair tied in a bun. K.MONTEIRO was carrying a white trash bag with her personal effects inside. K. MONTEIRO did have a cell phone but the number has been cancelled and only communicates through an application, using WIFI.
- (5) Ptlm. Perry said G. GROOM told him that K. MONTEIRO had left the Bethesda Shelter Housing in Pembroke, Ma and was given a ride back to 107 County Street. K. MONTEIRO stayed until 08/07/2025, at 1900 hours.
- (6) On 08/08/2025, Sgt. Jason Ferreira had spoken with K. MONTEIRO's sister who is identified as Faith Monteiro (F. Monteiro). F. Monteiro said that she had talked with F. Monteiro through texting with her.
- (7) F. Monteiro said that on 08/06/2025, she had received a text message from K. Monteiro at 7:43PM which stated the following "He threw me on the ground and pulled my hair and strangled me. My phones at 4% if I die it was greg".

(8) F. Monteiro said that the last contact she had with K. Monteiro was on 08/07/2025 at 1:46 PM "Im. Sorry me Greg went to go get food and im still here" F. Monteiro replied back "Are you staying there again tonight? 3:52 PM 'I think so idk we haven't talked yet were waiting till 3.

- (9) As of 08/11/2025, at approximately 0745hrs, there hasn't been any contact with K. MONTEIRO since 8/7/2025. K. MONTEIRO hasn't attempted to contact any of her family or friends. K. MOTEIRO was on social media and used many social media platforms to communicate frequently. This was prior to when she had gone missing. Since that time K. MONTEIRO has not been on any of the social media platforms that she would frequent.
- (10) On 08/11/2025, I called G. GROOM's phone number and spoke with his grand-father who said that G. GROOM was at the house. He went on to say that he couldn't receive cell phone calls because his cell phone was broken.
- (11) On 08/11/2025, at approximately 0954hrs, Sgt. James Casey and I went to 107 County Street to make contact with G. GROOM. We had our Axon Body Worn Cameras activated. We made contact with G. GROOM who was sleeping in a shed adjacent to the residence. I asked G. GROOM about his cell phone. G. GROOM said that it was broken and in the house. I asked G. GROOM to come back to the station for an interview.

(12) The following is a brief summary of the interview with G. GROOM: Interview was dictated by Trooper Ryan Foley:

- (13) On August 11, 2025, Detective Sergeant James Casey and I conducted an audio and video recorded interview with G. GROOM. G. GROOM was advised his Miranda Rights. He acknowledged that he understood them both verbally and in writing. He then indicated that he would speak with investigators.
- (14) At the beginning of the interview, G. GROOM was asked what he likes to do for fun. G. GROOM indicated that he has practiced martial arts with a friend for the last 6 years. He explained that he does not have

formal martial arts training and that he participates in "non-contact sparing". G. GROOM also indicated that he enjoys fishing with his family members. When asked who resides at 107 County St, Rehoboth, G. GROOM indicated that he, his brother (Riordan Groom) and his grandparents. He continued by explaining that he is currently employed by Hannaford's Supermarket, where he has worked for the last 6 months.

- (15) G. GROOM was then asked how he and K. MONTEIRO met. G. GROOM explained that they had met at a park near Angell St. Attleboro in February. This park was near his father's residence. G. GROOM continued by explaining that he was looking for new friends, which prompted him to speak with K. MONTEIRO and her friends Anna and Jacob. This led to G. GROOM and K. MONTEIRO frequently communicating via text message after that evening.
- (16) G. GROOM then explained K. MONTEIRO was in a "tough spot" with her friends and family, which led to her staying at the residence. G. GROOM initially believed that K. MONTEIRO was being abused by her aunt and uncle but later learned that it was a lie from K. MONTEIRO's friend Anna. When asked when he and K. MONTEIRO began having an intimate relationship, G. GROOM explained after approximately 2 months.
- (17) When asked to describe the relationship between he and K. MONTEIRO, G. GROOM indicated that it "stated off strong." He explained that the relationship began to strain, as he started to notice her becoming manipulative. He explained that
- (18) K. MONTEIRO would often manipulate people emotionally to get things that she wanted. Due to this behavior G. GROOM began to "drift away" from K. MONTEIRO approximately 2 ½ months to 3 months into the relationship. K. GROOM indicated that he attempted to end the relationship with K. MONTEIRO, which prompted her to state that she was pregnant. G. GROOM stated that she was lying about the pregnancy as there was no proof and that she constantly lied to her. When asked how he felt about the news that she was pregnant, G. GROOM stated that he was shocked and that he did not know what to do. He continued by explaining that K. MONTEIRO indicated that she had gone to the hospital with her sister, Faith Monteiro (DOB 11/15/00), where she learned she was pregnant with a boy. G. GROOM stated that he did not believe that due to it being too early to determine the gender.

(19) When asked if the relationship got better or worse, G. GROOM indicated that it was getting worse. He stated that K. MONTEIRO's lies increased and that it was "effortless" for her. G. GROOM indicated they would have daily arguments at his residence and denied them becoming physical. When asked if anyone had stepped in or witnessed these arguments, G. GROOM stated that no one had stepped but he knew people had heard them. He then identified K. MONTEIRO's friend Anna, as someone who had heard the arguments.

- (20) G. GROOM then stated that, before K. MONTEIRO ran away, he was on the phone with Faith Monteiro who was being told that he was cheating on her with Anna. He continued by explaining that he stopped talking to Anna a few months ago, approximal April, for the same reason. G. GROOM explained that he began speaking to Anna in early June to see if she could help him out with issues between him and K. MONTEIRO.
- (21) G. GROOM then explained that K. MONTEIRO had come over to his residence during the afternoon hours of August 6, 2025. He explained that she had been at the Bethesda House, who provided her with a Lyft to his residence. G. GROOM explained that she was there due to her being 9 weeks pregnant, to which he believed he was the father. When asked if he was excited about being the father, G. GROOM indicated that he was excited. He went on to explain that it was tough because they did not have anywhere to go and that she was not allowed at his residence. When asked why he believed her to be pregnant, G. GROOM stated that he had seen medical paperwork and that she is currently 9 weeks pregnant. G. GROOM explained that once he learned that she was pregnant he began saving money for a place for them to live.
- (22) G. GROOM then explained that on August 7, 2025, he and K. MONTEIRO spent the entire day searching for places for K. MONTEIRO to stay. He explained that they had reached out to several of K. MONTEIRO's friends and family members but were unsuccessful. He also explained that they had talked to K. MONTEIRO's sister Faith on August 6th and 7th regarding a place for her to stay.
- (23) On the night K. MONTEIRO went missing G. GROOM explained that he saw her walking on County St, towards Reservoir Ave. He explained that he remained at the top of his driveway and that it was the last time he spoke with her. This led G. GROOM to describe another time K. MONTEIRO had walked away from his residence, down County St. G. GROOM explained that he, Anna and K. MONTEIRO were in a vehicle together when an argument ensued. He stated that the argument was due to K. MONTEIRO believing Anna was getting in

between her and G. GROOM's relationship. G. GROOM explained that K. MONTEIRO walked down the street but later turned around and came back to the residence.

- When asked a second time if he and K. MONTEIRO had ever had a physical altercation, G. GROOM indicated that they had one previously. He explained that he was trying to talk to K. MONTEIRO, which led to a verbal argument. During the argument he attempted to remove K. MONTEIRO's phone from her hand, to which he stated, "she made it out to look like I was abusing her, hitting her. She said I put my knee on her chest so she couldn't breathe. When all I did was grab her arms so she could put the phone down and we could talk".
- When asked if K. MONTEIRO would go to Reservoir after leaving G. GROOM's, he stated that it was possible. He indicated that she had been talking about camping in Rehoboth, so she could be close to G. GROOM. G. GROOM went on to state that she did not have a tent with her when she left the residence. He continued by stating that he had shown her places to camp in the area approximately 1 month ago, which included the area around the reservoir.
- GROOM was again asked if anything physical had happened between him and H. MONTEIRO. G. GROOM denied anything physical happening between he and MONTEIRO. He again reaffirmed that the last time he had seen K. MONTEIRO was walking on County St, towards Reservoir Ave. G. GROOM also denied an accident happening on the night K. MONTEIRO was last seen. He also denied knowing where she was. Investigators then asked G. GROOM numerous times to get whatever was bothering him off his chest. G. GROOM remained silent, fidgety and avoided eye contact. After several minutes, G. GROOM retold in the story about trying to get the phone from her. He explained that she was making it look like he was abusive and that it did not make him feel good.
- (27) Detective McGovern then asked G. GROOM to walk him through the day K. MONTEIRO walked away from the residence. G. GROOM explained he woke up in the house around 8:30-9:00 AM, while K. MONTEIRO slept in the shed.
- (28) G. GROOM changed his story saying that there was an incident a few months ago where G. GROOM and K. MONTEIRO were arguing. K. MONTEIRO was texting friends on her cell phone and G. GROOM said

that he tried to take the K. MONTEIRO's cell phone from her hands. He then grabbed her arm. G. GROOM demonstrated how he grabbed K. Monteiro's arm. He used his left hand and grabbed his right wrist simulating grabbing K. MONTEIRO.

- (29) G. GROOM said that he and K. MONTEIRO were constantly arguing. During the interview G. GROOM said that he had gone with K. MONTEIRO to the Reservoir on Reservoir Ave to look at future camp sites. G. GROOM said that K. MONTEIRO wanted to camp and be close to G. GROOM.
- (30) G. GROOM said that K. MONTEIRO went out to the shed and took photographs of the injuries to her wrist. She then sent them out on social media telling her friends that G. GROOM was abusing and hitting her. G. GROOM said that this occurred two months ago.
- I asked G. GROOM to tell me about the day K. Monteiro walked to the end of the driveway onto County Street. G. GROOM said that Monteiro slept in the shed and G. GROOM slept inside the house. G. GROOM said that he woke up between 0830-0900 in the morning and went to check on K. Monteiro. G. GROOM said that he wanted to give K. Monteiro food and water. G. GROOM said that he and K. Monteiro tried calling family and friends looking for a place for her to go to. G. GROOM said that K. Monteiro stayed all day and left at 1900.
- (32) I asked G. GROOM if Kylee made plans to have someone pick her up. G. GROOM stated that K. MONTEIRO had called her sister Faith, but didn't know what the plan was.

At 12:10PM G. GROOM advised that he wanted to talk with his attorney and the interview was ended.

- (33) The last person to speak with and see K. MONTEIRO was G. GROOM on 08/07/2025 at 1900 hours. K. Monteiro has remained silent on social media since 08/07/2025 1900 hours.
- (34) Lt. Brock Morrisette of the Massachusetts State Police (MSP) Detectives Unit was notified and responding to the station. Upon arrival MSP Detectives were sent to 107 County Street and were given consent to search the property for K. Monteiro. Sgt. Casey and Sgt. Brock Morrisette along with several K9's went and

searched the residence and the surrounding area for K. Monteiro with negative results.

- (35) I remained in the station and assisted with conducting interviews of witness.
- (36) MSP Tpr. Mike Lajoie was the assigned as the primary case officer.
- (37) On 08/13/2025, the second day of the investigation the Massachusetts State Police Detectives, State Police Detectives, and Rehoboth Police Officers continued the investigation. (See State Police report / SERT report to follow.)
- (38) On 08/14/2025, the third day of the investigation the Massachusetts State Police Detectives, MSP SERT, SEMLEC Search and Rescue continued the investigation. A command post was established at the Dighton Rehoboth Regional High School. The State Police CERT was in command of the search. While the MSP Detectives continued to interview witnesses.
- (39) On 08/19/2025, G. GROOM came into the station with Faith Monteiro for an interview. Detective Lajoie and Detective John Pina escorted G. GROOM and F. Monteiro into the interview room adjacent in the booking room. Detective Lajoie advised G. GROOM of his Miranda Rights. G. GROOM waived his rights signing the form agreeing to speak with them.
- (40) During the interview G. GROOM stated that he was in the shed with K. MONTEIRO on 08/06/2025. He admitted to having a verbal altercation with K. MONTEIRO. G. GROOM stated that at one point he had pushed K. MONTEIRO. This caused her to hit her head on the shed door. G. GROOM said that K. MONTEIRO had a bump on the back of her head. Later in the interview G. GROOM was shown a text message from K. MONTEIRO to F. Monteiro. In that text message K. MONTEIRO told F. Monteiro the following, "He threw me on the ground pulled my hair and strangled me. My phones at 4% if I die it was greg". G. GROOM read the text message aloud and then G. GROOM stated that was on Wednesday. He denied pulling K. Monteiro's hair or strangling her. G. GROOM then admitted that after he pushed her K. Monteiro fell to the ground. He then went on to say that K. MONTEIRO was attempting to send a voice message to someone. G. GROOM said that he hit K. MONTEIRO's phone out of her hand to prevent her from sending the message.

- (41) Based on the facts and circumstances there is probable cause to believe that two months ago G. GROOM grabbed the cell phone out of K. MONTEIRO's hand and then grabbed her arm.
- (42) G. Groom admitted that on 08/06/2025, he pushed K. MONTEIRO causing her to hit her head on the door. G. GROOM said that there was an injury to the back of K. Monteiro's head. This story changed after he was shown a text message from K. MONTEIRO to her sister. He then admitted to pushing K. MONTEIRO
- (43) G. GROOM is being charged with the following: (1) Aggravated A&B (c. 265 s. 13A(d)(ii)). (2) A&B Household/Family member (c. 265 s.13M(a)). (3) Intimidation of a witness (c. 268 s. 13B).

DETECTIVE SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

(1) On 08/19/2025, at approximately 0848hrs, GREGORY GROOM (G. GROOM) came into the Rehoboth Police Department with KYLEE MONTEIRO's (K. MONTEIRO) sister who identified as Faith Monteiro (F. Monteiro). They came in for a follow up interview related to K. MONTEIRO who was still missing.

- (2) On 08/19/2025, at approximately 0900hrs, Massachusetts State Police Detective John Pina and Detective Mike Lajoie escorted G. GROOM and F. Monteiro into the interview room.
- (3) Detective Lajoie advised G. GROOM that the interview would audio and video recordered. Det. Lajoie advised K. Monteiro of the miranda rights from a prepared form. G. GROOM waived his constitutional rights signing the form agreeing to talk with the Detectives. A short time into the interview F. Monteiro exited the interview room.
- (3) During the interview G.GROOM admitted to murdering K. MONTEIRO and had drawn a map on a piece of paper as to the location of where K. MONTEIRO was located at G.GROOMS residence 107 County Street.
- (4) On 08/19/2025, the Massachusetts State Police and Rehoboth Police executed a search warrant at 107 County Street. During the search of the property human remains were located in an area which was described by G. GROOM.
- (5) Based on G. GROOMS admission of Murdering K. Monteiro and the recovery of human remains at 107 County Street, G.GROOM will be charged with C265 S1 Murder.
