Sir, Ma'am

On today's date of 10/29/2023, I Ofc. N. Pacheco was assigned to marked uniform patrol in Unit 11 while working the C-shift (1600-0000). At approximately 10:39PM, myself along with assisting units had responded to a report of a large disturbance at the residence of 827 County Street. Upon my arrival, I was the first unit to arrive on scene and as I approached the home I could see there was a group of approximately 100 to 160 individuals who were in the front yard.

As I made it to the front of the home half of the involved individuals scattered as they had seen authorities arrive at this residence and they had begun to disperse. I radioed to control to have supporting units step it up (come to the scene as soon as possible) as things were chaotic. The parties involved were a mixture of teenagers and grown adults who had been actively fighting with one another. Approximately myself along with 7 supporting units were beginning to get parties to disperse, and as the individuals began to move numerous parties brought their fights all over the area.

There were parties fighting in the middle of the road, the sidewalk and their had been a few vehicles that picked some teenagers up and they continued to make their rounds around the block repeatedly with parties yelling from the moving vehicles. The ratio of people compared to Officers were approximately 10 people to one officer. After some of the parties had left the scene their was approximately 80 people still remaining on scene attempting to prolong the altercation that had occurred here today. It was unsafe as vehicles had a hard time to pass by in the roadway as individuals were all over the block we had been on. People were impeding the roadway and running all around trying to continue the fighting.

As parties were separated a female by the name of Tamara Dejesus (2/7/1975) was found to have a bloody lip and when she was asked what it was that had happened here she stated she was jumped by numerous people but did not provide us with any names. I asked Tamara if medical attention was needed and she said "I'm fine I dont need an ambulance" Upon her explanation she stated a male who was involved in the breaking up of the large brawl was later identified as John Smith (7/28/1973) and she claimed she believes she was punched in the face by him as he broke parties apart.

At this time she did not want to press charges. I approached this male and he had no signs that he did throw a punch as his knuckles had no signs that they made contact with something that can only be caused due to a fight or striking an object. John later stated he was punched several times and pushed while he was trying to diffuse the situation that was occurring at the home. John was assisting with getting parties to break apart prior and after our arrival.

Tamara stated she came over to the house party to fight the one of the girls who had an issue with her daughter just one night prior at another house party. She did not state the name of the female she had the issues with. The woman who is responsible for hosting the party is Genelle Underwood (6/12/1990), Genelle stated this party was intended on being a small gathering with her daughter having some friends over and that was it. Her daughter Yasmine Underwood (4/09/2007) was supposed to have a small get together at the home in the basement and as her friends began to arrive, they began to invite friends of friends which led to this large gathering being blown out of proportion. At no point in time did Genelle attempt to slow or shut down this party at all.

Genelle had notified us that just earlier in the day Tamara aka (also known as) (Tammy) had texted her to discuss problems that their daughters have amongst themselves. As the party grew to be large Tamara walked over to the home that is approximately 25-50 yards away from her residence and she began to fight others. Multiple parties had proceeded to shout out she had gone over there and attempted to fight these minors and did not win. Although tempers were high, things slowly started to calm down as the majority of the individuals had left. Officer Andy Pereira provided a female by the name of Jayla Douglas (1/2/2007) with a curtacy ride to her home as she and others were exchanging words, which were only making matters worse. Ofc. Pereira calmed the situation down significantly by removing this female from the situation as the situation can no longer be provoked.

As parties were leaving the scene we had noticed numerous vehicles making round trips up and down the road repeatedly, as if they were looking for more issues as they had been yelling and taunting others as they commuted back and forth. The two vehicles making their rounds had been a 2018 Chevrolet Se Sonic Blue in color bearing Mass Tag #5EWB19, this vehicle belongs to Vanessa M Hokoana (1/13/1989). The second vehicle was a 2012 Hyuandai Se Sonata that is Gray in color, bearing Mass Tag 5RKH49 and this motor vehicle belongs to Jane Olive Vieira (8/05/1951).

Shortly after all the chaos had died down we had heard from people in the crowd that their was a potential that there may have been underage drinking going on at this residence. As Officer Jack Cordeiro, Officer Bruce Nicely as well as myself spoke with the female who was present on scene that had hosted the party (Gennelle Underwood, her apartment door had been slightly Ajar (open) and there were no signs of alcohol in our plain view that could be seen.

All the parties were moved along with no further incident and myself with responding units cleared the scene and began patrolling back to our designated areas.
